I struggle with loneliness.

Can God help me find companionship?

"Hi-ho Silver, away!"

Those are feel-good words. The bad guys are in jail. The good guys win. The sun sets. Everyone's happy. Well, almost everyone. At the end of the day, the hero is still the LONE Ranger.

Ever felt like the LONE Ranger? You saved the office from certain peril. You arrived with your son's glove just moments before he took the field. You made everyone happy. 


